It's that time of year when many of us wrap up the year by giving generously to some of our most treasured non-profit organizations doing amazing work for people who are far away in distance but close to our hearts. For many years, Our Savior's has partnered with three amazing organizations – Rancho Santa Marta, New Life Band, and MayaCREW.



Rancho Santa Marta (https://www.ranchosantamarta.org/)

provides a safe home and school for at-risk youth at their beautiful 450-acre ranch located in Northern Baja Mexico, about 150 miles south of San Diego. Our Savior's has partnered with RSM for decades sending youth, seniors, and family groups down to carry out various work assignments. RSM has a number of new buildings and even has modernized their classrooms with much-needed air conditioning. The newest RSM "staff" are 3

horses, who work with special-needs children. They constantly need funds for the ranch upkeep and various building projects.

New Life Band (https://newlifeband.org/) is part of an inter-denominational ministry that transforms the lives of youth and students in Tanzania. Our Savior's has partnered with the New Life Band for many years, having dazzled our audiences with their amazing music. The New Life School is in the process of transitioning from a secondary to a vocational school. They are currently working with the Tanzanian government for needed permits. Your donation this year will go toward purchasing much-needed computers and tables for the classrooms.



MayaCREW (http://www.mayacrew.org/wp/) supports children's education, leadership programs, and



well-being services in the Municipality of Chichicastenango, in the Highlands of Guatemala. Founded by Our Savior's, MayaCREW is celebrating their 20th year of operation. MayaCREW leadership works closely with a Guatemala-based non-profit (ACEBAR) to provide scholarships for young people (mostly girls) to help their families cover the expenses of primary and secondary public schooling in the municipality, setting up many to ultimately receive their

high school diplomas. Just last month, we celebrated with 28 students who completed their high school graduation. Your donations are used to support the scholarship program and the salaries of the ACEBAR staff.
